POPULATION: heterosexual, men who have sex with men, women, men, students, youth, adolescents, African American, Latino

RESPONSE OPTIONS: 4-point Likert scale ranging from 0 (never) to 3 (this has happened 6 or more times)

SCORING: Responses were added together for summed scores

SURVEY ITEMS:

Physical Abuse

- 1) I threw something at her/him
- 2) I kicked, hit, or punched her/him
- 3) I slapped her/him or pulled her/his hair
- 4) I pushed, shoved, or shook her/him

Threatening Behavior

- 1) I destroyed or threatened to destroy something she/he valued
- 2) I deliberately tried to frighten her/him
- 3) I threatened to hurt her/him
- 4) I threatened to hit or throw something at her/him

Sexual Abuse

- 1) I touched her/him sexually when she/he didn't want me to
- 2) I forced her/him to have sex when she/he didn't want to
- 3) I threatened her/him in an attempt to have sex with her/him
- 4) I kissed her/him when she/he didn't want me to

Relational Aggression

- 1) I tried to turn her/his friends against her/him
- 2) I said things to her/his friends about her/him to turn them against her/him
- 3) I spread rumors against her/him

Emotional and Verbal Abuse

- 1) I did something to try to make her/him jealous
- 2) I brought up something bad that she/he had done in the past
- 3) I said things just to make her/him angry
- 4) I spoke to her/him in a hostile or mean tone of voice
- 5) I insulted her/him with put downs
- 6) I ridiculed or made fun of her/him in front of others
- 7) I kept track of who she/he was with and where she/he was
- 8) I blamed her/him for the problem
- 9) I accused her/him of flirting with another guy/girl
- 10) I threatened to end the relationship

RELIABILITY INFORMATION: Cronbach's α values are: Sexual Abuse = 0.51, Threatening Behavior = 0.66, Verbal or Emotional Abuse = 0.82, Relational Aggression = 0.52, Physical Abuse = 0.83

VALIDITY INFORMATION: Reproducibility, Convergent Validity, and Factor Structure are reported
