INSTRUMENT TITLE: STaT: Slapped, Things, and Threaten

SOURCE ARTICLE: Paranjape, A. & Liebschutz, J. (2003). STaT: A Three-Question Screen for Intimate Partner Violence. *Journal of Women's Health*. 12(3): 233-239

POPULATION: heterosexual, women, African American, patients

RESPONSE OPTIONS: Yes/No

SCORING: A 'yes' response is given a 1 and a 'no' response is given a 0. Adding up all the responses gives the total score

SURVEY ITEMS:

- 1) Have you ever been in a relationship where your partner has push or slapped you?
- 2) Have you ever been in a relationship where you r partner has threatened you with violence?
- 3) Have you ever been in a relationship where your partner has thrown, broken, or punched things?
